

Privacy Policy

Effective as of July 11, 2014

Techdefence Labs takes privacy issues and your privacy very seriously. This Privacy Policy describes the personal information Techdefence Labs and its affiliated companies (“Techdefence Labs”) collects about you through www.techdefencelabs.com and its related websites (the “Site(s)”), why we collect it, how we use it, and when we share it with third parties. By using and visiting our Sites, you agree to the information collection and use practices described in this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any other Techdefence Labs product, service or application, or websites that display or link to different privacy policies. If you have any questions about this Privacy Policy, please contact us as described in the section entitled, “Contact Us”, below.

1. What information we collect

We collect both personal and non-personal information on our Sites. Personal information is information that can be used to identify you individually, such as your name, address, phone and fax numbers, and email address. Non-personal information may include information about how you use our Sites, the areas of our Sites that you visit, internet protocol (IP) address, browser type, and internet service provider (ISP). We will not knowingly collect or use personal identifying information from children younger than 13 without parental consent.

The following is a more detailed explanation of these types of information.

Personal Information

We may collect information that identifies you personally, such as your name, address, phone and fax numbers and e-mail address, when you submit a form, such as, but not limited to, a form that requests additional information about Techdefence Labs solutions. We may collect additional information if you choose to submit it, including, but not limited to: job title, employer, business telephone number, and mailing address. We will use this information to respond to your inquiry and to send you communications related to our solutions, products, services, promotions, company, and other products or services we think may be of interest to you. If you choose to submit your resume to us through our Sites or via a third party website, we will collect the information provided in order to contact you about potential employment opportunities.

Non-Personal Information

We and our third party service providers may collect non-personal information from you, including how you use our Sites and the areas of our Sites that you visit.

Log Files

As is true of most websites, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information includes IP addresses, browser type, ISP, referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp, and clickstream data. We use this information, which does not identify individual users, to analyze trends, to administer the site, to track users’ movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. We do not link this automatically-collected data to personally identifiable information.

Cookies

A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record-keeping purposes. We use cookies on the Sites. You should be aware that cookies contain no more information than you volunteer, and they are not able to "invade" your hard drive and return to the sender personal or other information from your computer. We use both session ID cookies and persistent cookies. We use session cookies to make it easier for you to navigate our site. A session ID cookie expires when you close your browser. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time. Persistent cookies enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance their experience on our site. You can remove persistent cookies by following directions provided in your Internet browser's "help" file. Many users prefer to use cookies in order to help them navigate a web site as seamlessly as possible. To learn more about cookies, please visit <http://www.allaboutcookies.org>.

Some Techdefence Labs pages use cookies that permit select third party partners, including Google, to provide you Techdefence Labs related content, including Techdefence Labs advertisements, on their sites or elsewhere on the Internet. This is based on your prior visits to our Sites.

Additionally, third parties may use cookies to allow you to link to social networking sites like Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. As noted above, you can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether to accept it. You can control whether or not these cookies are used, but preventing them may stop us from offering you some services. Alternatively you may use the third parties' own tools to prevent these cookies.

2. How we use information we collect

We collect personal information about you through the Sites to communicate with you about our solutions, products, services, promotions, company, and other products or services we think may be of interest to you. In addition, if you submit your resume, we will contact you about potential employment opportunities. As described in this policy, we may share your personal information with third parties that provide services on our behalf or with whom we have partnered to offer a particular product or service. We use non-personal information, which does not identify individual users, to improve user experience and overall quality of our Sites, to analyze trends, to administer the site, to track users' movements around the site and to gather demographic information about our user base as a whole. For example, each visitor to the Site is identified by an IP address during their visit and IP addresses are automatically captured by Site management software. Techdefence Labs uses this information to help improve the operation of the Site and may at some time use this information to help adjust the content of the Site to the general geographic location of the visitor and for reporting purposes. Because non-personal information does not personally identify you, we may also use and disclose non-personal information for any other purpose. We may combine personal information with non-personal information. If we do so, we will treat all combined information as personal information as long as it is combined.

3. How we share information with third parties

We will share your personal information with third parties only in the ways that are described in this policy. We do not sell your personal information to third parties and we will not provide any of your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes without your explicit consent. The personal and non-personal information you provide to the Site may be shared with our third party agents and service providers who help Techdefence Labs operate, analyze and

improve the Sites; help Techdefence Labs provide the services requested by you; contribute to Techdefence Labs's sales and marketing efforts; and help Techdefence Labs with its recruitment and staffing efforts.

We may also transfer and disclose information, including personal information, to third parties in order to comply with a legal obligation; when we believe that the law requires it; at the request of governmental authorities conducting an investigation; when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights; to investigate fraud; to respond to an emergency; or otherwise to protect the rights, property, safety, or security of users of the Sites or others.

In addition, In the event Techdefence Labs goes through a business transition, such as a merger, acquisition by another company, or sale of all or a portion of its assets, your personal information will likely be among the assets transferred. By providing your personal information, you agree that we may transfer such information to the acquiring entity without your further consent. You will be notified via email and/or a notice posted on our Sites of any such change in ownership or control of your personal information.

4. Security

The security of your personal information is important to us. Please be assured that we have security measures in place to protect against the loss, misuse and alteration of any personal information we receive from you. However, please remember that no data storage or data transmission is guaranteed to be 100% secure. Thus, while we strive to protect your personal information, Techdefence Labs cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us.

5. Links to other websites

The Sites may contain links to third party websites such as the websites of Techdefence Labs partner companies. Techdefence Labs takes no responsibility for the content, operation or privacy practices of such websites. This Privacy Policy does not apply to third party websites, and you should check the policies of any linked website before offering information to the sponsor of the website. Techdefence Labs provides these links to you only as a convenience, and the inclusion of any link to such websites does not imply endorsement by Techdefence Labs of those sites.

6. Techdefence Labs Blogs and other Forums

If you use a blog or similar forum, or other chat or similar tool that we may make available on the Sites, you should be aware that any personal information you submit there can be read, collected, or used by other users, and could be used to send you unsolicited messages. Techdefence Labs is not responsible for the personal information you choose to submit in these forums. You are also responsible for using these forums in a responsible and professional manner consistent with any applicable terms of use or other terms and conditions that may be set forth on the relevant forum site.

7. Where we hold data/Safe Harbor Framework

We operate the Sites from the United States. If you are located outside of the United States, please be aware that information we collect will be transferred to and processed in the United States. By visiting the Sites, or providing us with any information, you fully understand and unambiguously consent to this transfer, processing and storage of your information in the United

States, a jurisdiction in which the privacy laws may not be as comprehensive as those in the country where you reside and/or are a citizen.

We recognize that the European Community has established a data protection regime pursuant to Directive 95/46/EC, which applies to the European Economic Area ("EEA") and restricts companies in the EEA in transferring personal data about individuals in the EEA to the United States, unless there is "adequate protection" for such personal data when it is received in the United States. To create such "adequate protection" and to overcome the restriction on international data transfers established by the Directive, Techdefence Labs complies with the U.S.-E.U. Safe Harbor framework and the U.S.-Swiss Safe Harbor framework as set forth by the U.S. Department of Commerce regarding the collection, use, and retention of personal data from European Union member countries and Switzerland. Techdefence Labs has certified that it adheres to the Safe Harbor Privacy Principles of notice, choice, onward transfer, security, data integrity, access, and enforcement.
